Shoal Group confirms that the products supplied comply to the directive of the European Parliament, Council on the Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electronic Equipment (European Directive 2011/65/EU RoHS2 & Directive (EU) 2015/863) and the Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2012.
